Warm Up:

1. Start your small group time with prayer. Share stories about what God is up to and pray for those who don't yet follow Jesus.
2. Which neighbors are you praying for and how have you engaged them over the last week? How do you sense the Spirit leading you in this regard?

Dig In:

3. In the first part of Acts 16, we meet Timothy, a man who would become vital to Paul. Do you have a Timothy? Have you been Timothy to someone? Share what this experience was like.
4. How can we invest in the lives of younger believers in our lives? What are the benefits of this? What are the struggles?
5. Read Acts 17:16-34. What are the highlights of Paul's visit in Athens? What stands out about his encounter in the Areopagus? What can you practically employ from his strategy there as you engage your community?
6. In Acts 18 we meet Aquila, Pricilla, and Apollos. What are the characteristics of these three people? How are they similar? Different?
7. Have you ever had an "Apollos encounter"? Were you Apollos or were you Aquila and Priscilla? What was the outcome of this encounter?

Live Out:

8. Who is God leading to pour your life into? Pray for them and the strategy for your investing in them.
