4. Read Matthew 22:34-40. Why does Jesus seem to sum up all the commandments with "loving God, and loving others?" How does one love God with all their heart, soul, mind, and strength, as well as love their neighbor as themselves, practically?

Action Over Words:

5. What are some practical ways that you are able to grow in patience, generosity, selflessness, joyfulness, and your commitments.
6. Pray together that God would use you to be love to the world, so that He may be glorified and known.
