Authentic Community:

1. Share with the group something that you read from the Bible Reading Plan that struck you. How is God challenging you to change as a result?
2. Is finding approval in God alone something you struggle with? Why or why not? Why is approval something we are so desperate for?

Grace & Truth:

3. Read Ephesians 2:1-10. There is a stark contrast between the way Paul describes us in the first four verses of Ephesians 2 and the next six verses. Do you feel this tension in your life? How does it manifest itself?
4. Read Matthew 5:13-16. Jesus calls his disciples both salt and light? In what ways are we salt? In what ways are we light? How do we sometimes, "light our lamp and put it under a bowl?"

Action Over Words:

5. What are the things you are most passionate about? How do those passions align with God's desire to see himself glorified?
6. How can you use your passions to bring God glory this week?
